There is level access from the main entrance to:

Travel by public transport

Bus

- Take the number 2 bus to Thornleigh Drive, Overpool.
- 20 min walk - 1 mile - along Overpool/Rivacre road, onto Netherpool road, right on Poole Hall Road and we're at Unit 1 Olympic Park.

Train

- Nearest stop is 'Overpool' on the Liverpool to Ellesmere Port line.
- 20 min walk - 1 mile - along Overpool and Rivacre road, right onto Poole Hall Road. Unit 1 Olympic Park.

Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Terrific Taxis 0151 374 2728. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

Parking

- There is a large car park on site with accessible parking spaces close to the front entrance.
- There is a cycle rack on site
- There are two EV Charging points available in the car park.



Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the car park to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 990mm wide, or more.
- The path is sloped.

Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The door is 840mm wide.

Getting around inside

Ticket/ information desk

Ticketing area

- From the main entrance to the desk, there is level access.
- The desk has a low section.
- We have a complimentary ticket policy for personal assistants.

Unisex Accessible Toilet

- There is an accessible public toilet.
- From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access. The toilet door is 800mm wide.
- There is 780mm in front of the toilet. The toilet seat is 480mm high.
- There are horizontal grab rails located to the left of the toilet. There are baby changing facilities within this toilet.



The Shop

- From the main entrance to the shop, there is level access.
- The route through the shop is 800mm wide, or more.

Place to eat and drink

Café area

- To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- We provide soya milk for coffee, tea and hot chocolate.

Customer care support

Accessibility equipment

- We have a portable hearing loop located at the front desk.
- We welcome assistance dogs and can provide water bowls for them. Please ask staff for assistance.

Emergency evacuation procedures

- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.
